Golden Rule Baseball Team, Last
Years Champions, Are
Reorganized.

CAPTAIN TO BE NAMED
AT MEETING NEXT WEEK

Schedule-Making Is Already Un-
der Way and Two Games Are
Already in Sight.

A. Shapiro was elected manager of this year's Golden Rule baseball team at a meeting of the members last evening. Eight of last year's "champ" nine were present and signified their desire to play with the G. R.'s.
