

WIFE OF MURDERED MAN PROVES LOYAL

CANNOT REALIZE HER HUSBAND LOVED OTHER WOMEN.

ANGRY MILLINER SLAYER

Walks Into Office While in Jealous Fit of Rage and Shoots Former Sweetheart to Death Before Witnesses.

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 12.—Mrs. J. D. Van Baalen, widow of J. D. Van Baalen, who was shot to death by Leah Alexander, a milliner, in a fit of jealous frenzy, has returned to San Francisco to attend the trial of her husband's slayer. The Alexander woman and Van Baalen were intimate for over a year. When he ceased showering his attentions upon her to give them to some other woman not his wife, she shot him to death in his office in the presence of several terrified witnesses. At that time Mrs. Van Baalen was visiting in Minnesota.

Of Different Type.
She has none of the dash and the fire which characterize the Titian-haired woman whose fate now hangs in the balance. Mrs. Van Baalen is crushed and dazed, but not as the shocked Van Baalen's death. She can scarcely believe that her husband's life has been snuffed out by a jealous woman.

Married Ten Years.
"I was married 10 years," she said. "In that time I was never unhappy. I never wanted for anything. I was always well cared for. My husband was as kind as a husband could be."
