

# PLAYWRITER DIES IN HOSPITAL AT BROOKLYN

NEW YORK, Nov. 14.—David Cohen, who under the pen name of Daniel D. Carter wrote "The Master Mind" and other plays, died late last night in a hospital in Brooklyn, it became known here tonight.
