

# RIVAL RANGE FIRMS TAKE THEIR TROUBLES TO COURT

HIBBING, July 22.—An interesting case was heard in district court by Judge Hughes, between Buhley & Edlestein, proprietors of the Royal Dye house, and Latz Brothers, formerly of Hibbing, but now of Virginia.

A year ago Buhley & Edlestein bought out the interest of Latz Bros., who were to move to Virginia with the agreement that Latz Bros. were to get work of a certain grade sent to them at Virginia and in consideration of that agreement were not to solicit business in Hibbing.

For three months the agreement was kept, then the Royal Dye house stopped shipping certain work to Virginia and Latz Bros. began active work soliciting work here. This was brought out in district court, and the Royal Dye house wants damages.

Judge Hughes took the matter under advisement and the arguments will be filed by brief Friday.
