
Jacob Levitz Not Guilty.

In the city police court yesterday, before Justice Wade and a jury, was heard the case of the state vs. Jacob Levitz, a dealer in second hand furniture, Fargo. The defendant was charged with the wrongful removal of a stove belonging to W. H. Dudrey from a house in Moorhead. The testimony disclosed that two stoves were involved in the dispute, the explanations of which were considerably complicated and no criminal intent whatever was shown. The evidence given by one Arthur Nethvin established in the minds of the jury that the whole trouble was purely one of misunderstanding and the jury returned a verdict of "not guilty".
