

# FINED FOR SLAUGHTERING ANIMALS WITHIN LIMITS

Jacob Goldberg, proprietor of a slaughter house near John avenue and Fifth street, yesterday paid a \$10 fine for killing animals within one-eighth of a mile of a dwelling or public highway.

The offense comes within the jurisdiction of the state health department. Goldberg's arrest is the first one in Superior for some time. He was arrested by W. C. Bennett, state inspector of health. It is understood that other arrests on the same charge will be made.
