

# MARKET PROBERS TO CONVENE AT EVELETH TODAY

EVELETH, Nov. 13.—The joint committee appointed by Mayor Jacob Stari to investigate the municipal market with a view of either changing methods of business there or closing it will meet tomorrow morning.

Members of the council committee are Sam Owens, Mike Langdon, George Mesberg and J. S. Wilson. The members of the special committee appointed by the mayor to cooperate with the council committee are Peter Peterson, a grocer; Willard Paylis, superintendent of the Leonidas mine; J. C. Poole and W. G. Harvey.

The investigation grows out of opposition of merchants here to the maintenance of a city market, which, they claim, interferes with legitimate business. They base their opposition upon the belief that the city is without legal power to conduct a market.
