

# DENYES ARRESTED; CHARGE OF ASSAULT

Ben Cohen of Virginia Brings  
Local Merchant Into Court  
Over Dog.

VIRGINIA, March 30.—Upon the complaint of Ben Cohen, shoemaker, J. P. Denyes was arraigned in municipal court this morning upon a charge of assault and battery.

The trouble arose over Cohen being bitten by a bulldog owned by Denyes.

When he approached the owner of the dog and complained of having been injured by the canine, it is alleged Denyes became angry and resorted to violence.

Judge Gillespie imposed a fine of \$5 and costs and warned the defendant to keep the dog muzzled and chained up. The sentence was suspended.

Cohen is not satisfied with the outcome of the case and declares he will commence an action for damages for having been attacked and bitten by the dog.
