

SHIPS SIX CARLOADS OF DULUTH HORSES TO EUROPEAN WAR

After starting on their way to the European war, four carloads of Duluth horses, Moses Golberg, owner of the Zenith Sales stable, arrived home from St. Paul last night. The deal was made with W. Bronson, agent of the South St. Paul horse market.

The Duluth "conscripts" were sent to St. Louis, Mo., last night whence they will be sent to France, via New York city, Golberg said. The horses are intended for the French cavalry.

The animals were perfectly conditioned, each weighing from 1,200 to 1,400 pounds, Golberg declared.
