

# SHANEDLING WAS NOT SERIOUSLY INJURED

TOWER, Oct. 11.—The work of salvaging the Fay hotel truck which turned turtle at Six Mile lake, Saturday morning and in which Munroe Shanedling was seriously injured, proceeded without interruption. Men and teams went to work late at night and early in the morning and brought in the car.

Dr. J. W. Burns of the Soudan hospital reports that Shanedling received a dislocation of the right hip and also internal injuries, but has no broken bones and that if all goes well the patient will be able to return to his home in Virginia in a few days.

Shanedling was pinned under the car and was unconscious more than an hour and was at first thought to be dead.
