

SCHOOL CHILDREN

PROVIDE FOR NEEDY

EVELETH, Nov. 25.—As a means of returning thanks for the benefits they have received during the year, the school children of Eveleth assumed the responsibility of seeing that no poor family in the city was without a suitable Thanksgiving dinner, and as a result the Associated Charities of the city had ample material for distribution to all the needy.

The custom is one which has existed in the Eveleth schools for many years and the children bring money, necessities and many things which they wish to have the poor people of the city enjoy at their expense.

In past years the distribution has been made by a committee of children, but the task of locating needy persons was more than they could take care of and the work has been turned over to the Associated Charities, whose agents have been able to investigate all cases reported.

The collection of food, which had piled up at headquarters yesterday was amazing, not only in quantity, but in some cases in character. Cookies, apples, candy and cake were there in plenty, while two youngsters surprised those in charge by bringing a considerable "chunk" of venison. The distribution was made by the advisory committee under the direction of Miss Esther Rabinowitz, secretary of the Associated Charities.
