

SHANEDLING'S ARM IS BROKEN AND RESET

VIRGINIA, Dec. 1.—Munro Shanedling, the member of the Virginia high school football team who was injured when the auto bus carrying the team to Ely this fall capsized on a hill near Tower, has just undergone a successful operation on his arm at St. Barnabas hospital in Minneapolis, according to information received here today.

The arm, which was broken at the time of the accident, had to be broken over and reset. Shanedling will be able to return to Virginia in about 10 days, according to the physicians.
