

PLAN PAGEANT TO MARK HANNUKAH

Duluth Jews to Take Part in Celebration at Adas Israel Synagogue Tomorrow.

CHILDREN WILL PRESENT ALLEGORICAL TABLEAUX

Commemorates Victory of Maccabees in Preserving Race Rather Than Battle Triumphs.

Sufferings of Jews in Europe during the present conflict and the natural antipathy of the race against war are striking features of the Hanukkah celebration which will take place at Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street, tomorrow night.

Rabbi W. Kissin, director of the Moses Montefiore Jewish school, has arranged an unique program which has for its principal attraction an allegorical pageant, depicting the several holidays in the Hebrew calendar.

Three little girls present the introductory phase, emphasizing that the festival of Hanukkah commemorates the efforts of the Maccabees in preserving the Jewish race, rather than sing the praises of victorious warriors of bloody battlefields.

Seven Children In Tableau.

Following the impressive ceremonial of kindling the lights seven youngsters, each representing a holiday and one emblematic of the congregation, engage in a series of dialogues and tableaux in which the significance of the Jewish feasts is explained.

The climax is reached when one of the lads gives a graphic description of the trials of Jewish war sufferers, many of whom are now starving on the steppes of Siberia.

The program will begin at 7 o'clock and is open to the public. Those who will take part and their respective roles follow:

Irene Bergstein, Anna Winer and Mollie Singer, introductory; Joe Fox, kindles lights; Morris Zlatkovsky, Adas Israel congregation; Bennie Garon, Channukah; Sherman Kasmir, Passover; Bennie Toback, Pentecost, the feast of weeks; Sam Casmir, Succoth, the feast of tabernacles; Agnes Safer, the solemn days of Rosh Hashannah and Yom Kippur; Carl Kaplan, representing Zionism.

There will be no admission charge. an announcement by Rabbi Kissin yesterday was to the effect that there will be no appeal for donations of any kind.
