

# PAGEANT DEPICTED IN JEWISH PROGRAM

Pupils of the Moses Montefiore School Delight a Large Audience.

Pupils of Moses Montefiore school last night gave an interesting program, the principal attraction of which was an allegorical pageant, depicting eight of the holidays on the Hebrew calendar. Several hundred persons filled the Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third Street, where the entertainment took place.

Rabbi W. Kissin, director of the school, who arranged the program, received congratulations from many of the spectators. Following the impressive ceremony of kindling the lights, seven pupils, each representing a holiday, and one emblematic of the congregation, gave a series of dialogues and tableaux in which the significance of the Jewish feasts was explained.

The climax was reached when one of the boy pupils painted a word picture of the trials of the Jews during the present great conflict. Many Hebrews are now starving on the steppes of Russia, where they have been forced to take refuge.
