## Shenowskys Separated in Russia—Both Came to America, Entered Grocery Business.

Thirty-five years ago Joseph Shenowsky bade good-bye to his brother, Mat Shenowsky, in Kiev, Russia. Ten years later Mat came to Duluth. Joseph is now a grocer in Chicago; Mat a grocer in Duluth.

Yesterday they were exchanging reminiscences. The Chicago brother is paying the Duluth brother a visit.

Next Sunday night there will be a celebration at the Shenowsky home in honor of the Chicago man. The

occasion will be in the nature of a reunion and relatives of the Shenowsky family will be guests.

Although the brothers have known each other's whereabouts, neither has corresponded until the last two months. Out of this correspondence came the sudden decision of Joseph Shenowsky to take a "squint" at Duluth.

He had first gone to Marinette, Wis., started a grocery store there and succeeded so well that he removed 13 years later to Chicago and started a larger store.

Mat Shenowsky left Russia in 1890, came direct to Duluth and started to work for the Board of Trade livery. He worked as a drayman for three years. Then he entered the grocery business.
