

JEWISH RELIEF WORK ORGANIZED AT EVELETH

EVELETH, Sept. 15.—A permanent organization to be known as the Jewish Relief committee for War Sufferers was organized during the holidays in Eveleth and already considerable work has been started toward the raising of funds for this purpose.

The organization probably will be used as a headquarters for all relief work for Jews done on the Mesaba range and will work in conjunction with the American Jewish Relief committee and the Central Jewish Relief committee, both of New York city.
