IS '17' TRACK LEADER

Harold Cavanaugh, junior at Central high school, was elected captain for the Central 1917 track team at a meeting of the squad Friday afternoon at the school.

"Cavy" is one of the star long-distance runners at the school, and was one of the entrants at the state meet held last month at Minneapolis.

The new captain will succeed Skuli Hrutfiord, dash man and jumper, and it is hoped that he will develop a winning team.
