

SHE SAVES \$50 FROM FIRE; HANDS BURNED IN FOURTH AVE. BLAZE

Mrs. Mabel Wilson, 328 Third avenue West, was burned about the hands yesterday morning while saving \$50 in currency which was threatened by fire in the tailor shop and dry cleaning establishment operated by Joseph Oreckovsky, at 28 Fourth avenue West, where she is employed.

The \$50 was in a purse in the rear of the room and represented her savings for a payment on furniture. After the alarm was sounded Miss Wilson ran to where she had left her purse. Before she got to the street she was burned about the hands, but she carried the money with her.

Starting from a tub of gasoline, ignited from a gas stove, the fire caused slight damage to the interior of the store. A large amount of clothing was ruined by smoke and water.
