

LUZAICH SALOON UNDER CITY BAN

Council Cites Man to Show Cause Why License Should Not Be Revoked.

MANY PERMITS RENEWED

May Day Batch of Permits Handled at Meeting of the City Commissioners.

A resolution citing Mike Luzach, proprietor of a saloon at 625 West Superior street, to appear before the city council next Monday and show cause why his license should not be revoked was adopted by the council at its regular meeting yesterday.

In a communication to Public Safety Commissioner Silberstein, Chief of Police McKercher asserts that Luzach has been convicted of selling liquor illegally at his residence, 631 West First street, and that the evidence showed the liquor was hauled from the saloon during the nighttime and on Sundays. Chief McKercher recommends that the license be revoked.
