

# MANY MILK BOTTLES, A CUT, CAUSE SUIT

Sarah Codel Injured Hand While  
Sacking Rebate—Asks  
\$1,000 Now.

---

Milk bottles which Sarah Codel had in her little grocery and confectionery store, upon which she demanded a rebate, started all the trouble now being aired in district court before Judge Dancer and a jury. P. J. Hickey and his driver, Ole Olson, being defendants in the case.

According to the testimony introduced yesterday Mrs. Codel claimed she had 64 bottles, Hickey counted 57 and his driver 41. This started a dispute. The driver proceeded to take the bottles, according to his testimony, at the direction of Hickey. Mrs. Codel, who had only been offered 60 cents for the lot, resented. In so doing she cut her hand.

The trial now in progress is to determine whether Mrs. Codel is entitled to damages in the amount of \$1,000, which she asks. Plaintiff's attorney is endeavoring to show the number of bottles in dispute and how much rebate the plaintiff was entitled to at the rate of 5 cents per bottle, a rebate ticket, calling for 5 cents being introduced in evidence. This, together with the injury to the plaintiff's hand, is the basis of the complaint.
