

WILL FOLLOW RULES ON RETURN OF BREAD

**Leamon Notifies Agencies That
Order Will Be in Effect
Tuesday.**

George W. Leamon has notified the council of national defense that he will begin Tuesday to follow the suggestion of food conservation by refusing the return privilege of stale bread. Between 200 and 300 agencies, mostly in Superior, are affected.

This date has been set for the bakeries in all parts of the country to discontinue the stale bread returns as a measure of conserving the nation's food supply. Several letters on the subject have been received by Leamon, who does the bulk of bakery business through agencies, and he has agreed to follow all the rules laid down by the national council.
