

WOMAN SERIOUSLY HURT IN STREET CAR ACCIDENT

Mrs. E. H. Edelstein, Hibbing, in
Hospital Suffering From In-
ternal Injuries.

HIBBING, Aug. 29.—Mrs. E. H. Edelstein, Pine street, is in a Hibbing hospital as the result of a street car accident tonight just north of the First street viaduct. She suffered a fractured right leg and internal injuries.

Witnesses do not agree as to how the accident occurred. According to one story, the east bound Mesaba street car struck a cow belonging to Mrs. Edelstein, which, in turn struck her. The cow died a few minutes later from injuries. Others declare that the car struck Mrs. Edelstein and the cow simultaneously, Mrs. Edelstein being on one side of the track and the cow on the other.

The streetcar motorman was F. J. Heneman, Virginia, but he could not be reached by the Hibbing police, who are investigating.

Mrs. Edelstein became confused when she saw the street car and automobiles from each direction approaching.
