

BOVEY COUNCIL HOLDS ORGANIZATION MEETING

BOVEY, April 4.—The Bovey council organized last night with only one new member, Edward Chucker. The old members of the board are Erik Johnson, president; James Barlow and Roderick Hawley, trustees, and C. J. Franti, clerk.

President Johnson appointed Hawley chairman of the finance and water and light committee; Chucker, chairman of the license, police and fire protection, and purchasing committees, and Barlow chairman of printing and public schools, streets and alleys and public buildings committees.

Dr. Edward Feguin, Gus Anders and Frank Radosevich were appointer members of the board of health committee. The Itasca Iron News was designated official paper. Gus Anders was reappointed policeman. Bids were ordered advertised for a city scavenger. J. K. Jasper was appointed fire warden and Elton F. Bailey, justice of the peace, to fill a vacancy made by an official failing to qualify.

Mr. Bailey was before the council in the interest of the Bovey baseball club. The council promised to investigate and made him "judge."
