Minneapolis, Minn., March 22.—North Dakota farmers yesterday joined with Minnesota farmers in asking Charles J. Brand, chief of the Markets bureau, to recommend changes in the proposed federal grain grades...

The spokesman for the North Dakota farmers was J. N. Hagan, commissioner of agriculture and labor. The most important changes he demanded were lowering of test weight, elimination of class four, leaving only classes 1, 2, 3 and sample; that barley be taken out of the so-called inseparables and put in with rye...
