## RECEIVES APPOINTMENT TO OFFICER TRAINING CAMP

Serg. Jacob Garon, son of Mr. and Mrs. J. Garon, 517 Fourth avenue East, has received an appointment to the officers' training camp, Zachary Taylor, Louisville, Ky., according to word received here by his parents. Garon enlisted in Duluth immediately after the United States declared war on Germany and was a member of the One hundred and Twenty-fifth field artillery at Camp Cody, Deming, N. M. Later he was transferred to the One hundred and Twenty-sixth field artillery and did not embark for overseas as did his former comrades.

Garon is under the age required to hold an officer's commission but at the time he graduates from the officers' training camp he will have reached the required age.

Garon is a graduate of Central high school, class of 1916. During his high school days he participated in many activities. In his senior year he was editor of the Zenith, Central high's annual publication, one of the highest honors to be achieved by a student at Central.
