

VIRGINIAN FEARS FOR KIN IN ERSTWHILE RUSSIAN POLAND

VIRGINIA, March 3.—Ben Cohen, Virginia man, five years a resident of the United States, is intensely interested in the new hostilities between Russia and Germany, for his family, from whom he has had no word for three years, is now within the zone of Teuton operations, in a part of Europe once called Russian Poland.

Cohen has made repeated attempts to get into communication with his kin, but all to no avail, and he fears that they may have succumbed to war's ravages. Much of the devastatory fighting has been waged through the section from which he came and many a sanguinary encounter has been told in the newspapers.
