

COUNCIL DENIES

LICENSE TO NINE;

GRANTS NUMBER

Unfavorable Police Reports and Fact of Alien Status Leaves Several In Lurch.

Soft drink and hotel licenses were denied nine applicants at the city commissioners' meeting yesterday, either because of unfavorable police reports or because the applicants were aliens. Several applicants, according to Commissioner of Public Safety B. Silberstein, have been in this country from eight to 14 years and still have not made application for even first papers.
