

LOUIS ROSENZWEIG BACK FROM CAMP, TELLS OF HOSPITAL

Louis Rosenzweig, son of Mr. and Mrs. Paul Rosenzweig, and brother of "Mose," who is now in France, returned last night from Camp Logan, Texas, where he has been stationed in the camp surgeon's office at camp headquarters, as a sanitary inspector. He has received his honorable discharge from the service, and reports that out of 30,000 men in the camp, but 155 died during the influenza epidemic, and that the base hospital there claims the record of any military camp in the country in this respect.

He also reports that the hospital is now being used as a convalescent base hospital for the wounded soldiers who are being returned from the battlefronts, and that many wounded and gassed men have already arrived.
