

JUDGE PAM, DR. MARCUS TO TELL OF JEWS' HOPES

Zionist Organization of Duluth Plans Mass Meeting Tonight on Current Themes.

Conditions among the Jewish people today are a thousand-fold worse than in the darkest days of the past. Duluthians will be told tonight at a mass meeting at Shrine auditorium, beginning at 8 o'clock. The meeting will be held under the auspices of the Zionists.

To correct the deplorable situation, a world-wide movement is on its feet, and the meeting tonight is a part of it.

Prominent speakers have been brought here to address Jewish and other peoples on various subjects relating to the problem. Judge Hugo Pam of Chicago, said to be one of the best informed men in the world on Jewish conditions, will speak in English, and Dr. I. Marcus, who has been called the best Yiddish speaker in this country, will talk in that tongue.

Dr. Lefkovits is Chairman.

Sol Bublick, president of the Zionist organization of Duluth, will introduce Dr. Maurice Lefkovits, who will act as chairman of tonight's meeting.

"Never in the history of the world has the Jewish existence been so intolerable," said Judge Pam yesterday. "The entire Jewish history written with the blood of our ancestors, cannot be compared with the unendurable suffering our people are undergoing at the present time. The chaotic turmoil of the countries, it was hoped, would appease the world, teach it the spirit of intolerance and bring it to a realization of the brotherhood of man and the fatherhood of God."

Judge Pam and Dr. Marcus propose to tell Duluthians how this hope has been shattered.
