

BETTER EXPRESS SERVICE IS DEMANDED AT VIRGINIA

VIRGINIA, Oct. 17.—Better express service was demanded tonight at a meeting of the Retail Merchants' association. A resolution to that effect will be forwarded to Clayton W. Smith, Duluth, superintendent of the Head of the Lakes district, by a committee composed of C. W. Irwin, L. M. Berger, Morris Shanedling, C. M. Taylor and M. K. Baer.

It was also decided that members unable to obtain satisfaction for damage done to packages in transit from express companies within 30 days should turn the matter over to the association to push. Complaint was made that some claims of two years' standing are still unsettled.
