

WOMAN TELLS HOW NICE MAN TALKED OF GOD

Wife of Chisholm Victim of Al- leged \$10,000 Swindle Tes- tifies in Hibbing Court.

HIBBING, Nov. 12.—Mrs. Louis Roth, wife of the the alleged victim of a swindle that lost him \$10,000, was the principal witness today for the state in the case of Solomon Rubloff, on trial here for the alleged swindle.

Mrs. Roth was on the stand two hours. For more than an hour she was cross-examined by Victor L. Power, attorney for the defense.

Mrs. Roth testified she believed a man named Green one of the alleged swindlers, was an honest man because he was so religious.

"God does not make money, man does that," Green was quoted as having told her. "There is no harm in me manufacturing money as long as it goes for the benefit of mankind. Do I not give it to all the poor and to the Red Cross?" he is said to have exclaimed.

Mrs. Roth testified concerning correspondence that passed between her and Green relative to Rubloff. The defense tried to bring out the fact that Roth and Green were "framing" against Rubloff.

Mrs. Roth testified Green told her both he and Rubloff would take the "manufactured" money to Minneapolis where it would be placed in circulation.

The case is expected to continue for several more days.
