

TWO BOYS HURT BY AUTOMOBILE

Police Seek Driver of Car; Accident Follows Liberty Loan Parade.

VIRGINIA. April 14. — Wallace Walker, aged 7, and Rudolph Soloski, aged 12, were struck and injured by an automobile following the Victory loan parade this afternoon at Fifth avenue and First street south. The driver of the automobile is still unknown, but the police are attempting to locate him.

The boys were taken to a local hospital, where it was found that Soloski's condition is serious. It is believed that he suffered internal injuries. Wallace escaped with a few bruises.

Witnesses reported to the police that the boys were playing in the street. The automobile passed over Soloski, according to the police report.

Miner Will Be Buried.

VIRGINIA, April 14.—Funeral services for Charles Fajan, killed in a landslide at the Alpena mine, early Sunday, will be held Wednesday afternoon from the Polish Catholic church under the auspices of St. Peter's and St. Paul's society. Rev. Father Meger will officiate.

Three men working with Fajan escaped injury. He is survived by his widow and two children.
