PLEDGE AID IN TEST

Jewish Socialists of Duluth pledged their support last night to the cases instituted at Chicago testing the constitutionality of the conscription law.

An active campaign to raise funds for this purpose will be started in the city at once. H. Singer who presided at the meeting said last night.

"Those now in the county jail, held for failing to register, will be asked to contribute to their own freedom also, there being some in jail whom I believe are willing to give.

"There was not a large attendance at the meeting held at the local headquarters, 118 First avenue West, but those present contributed \$15 and there were several pledges for more."
