

HIBBING ZIONISTS ELECT OFFICERS

New York Leader Urges Jews to Work for Restoration of Palestine.

HIBBING, July 9.—The Zionists of Hibbing have elected officers for the ensuing year. Several hundred members were present at Erspamer's hall when Dr. H. Grossman of New York, one of the national Zionist leaders, addressed the assemblage on the movement. He stated that the other peoples of the world had a new birth with the ending of the war and that they now had nations they could call their own. He urged the Jewish people to work to that end and have Palestine restored to them as their kingdom. Dr. Grossman is a forcible speaker.

Officers elected for the ensuing year follow: E. W. Woolfan, president; Rev. R. Gusse, vice president; A. Sachs, treasurer; E. G. Bloom, secretary; trustees, Charlie Hallock, Mrs. Hallock, Louis Holstein, Maurice Wolf and Aron Ballet.

D. Bloom was named a delegate to the convention to be held in Chicago soon and at which all the range towns will send delegates. There were visitors present at Sunday's meeting from Chisholm, Buhl, Kinney, Virginia, Duluth and Eveleth. It was one of the largest gatherings of Jewish people held here in some time.
