

# TWO MEN ARE ARRAIGNED ON CHARGES OF LARCENY

Two larceny cases were called in municipal court yesterday by Judge Richard M. Funck. Abe Fagel was arraigned on a charge of grand larceny in the second degree. His hearing was set for 2 o'clock today, with bail fixed at \$300. He is alleged to have stolen \$71 in cash.

Roy Hovinen, charged with petty larceny, pleaded guilty and was sentenced to a fine of \$25 and costs, with an option of spending 30 days in the county jail. He paid the fine. Hovinen is alleged to have stolen a wrist watch valued at \$25 from Hjalmer Edward Hill.
