

SCHAPERY DENIES CHARGE OF RECKLESS DRIVING

Harry Schapery, 212 Third avenue East, yesterday pleaded not guilty to a charge of reckless driving brought against him in municipal court on complaint of Charles Erickson. Erickson charges that on July 26 Schapery was driving his auto on First street and Twenty-ninth avenue West at a rate of speed that endangered the life of his wife, Ellen Erickson. Judge F. H. Cutting released Schapery on \$100 bail and set a hearing for Aug. 5.

Schapery's auto, it is alleged, climbed the sidewalk knocking down Mrs. Erickson and throwing her four-weeks-old baby out of the carriage she was wheeling. Mrs. Erickson has been confined to her home with injuries, but the baby was unhurt.
