ENGAGE MUNICIPAL COURT

Russell Briggs, charged with reckless driving, pleaded not guilty in municipal court yesterday. A jury trial of the case was set for Sept. 9, and Briggs was released without bail. The case of H. Schapery, charged with reckless driving, was continued to Aug. 26. John P. Rogge pleaded guilty to a charge of driving without a state license and was fined \$10 with the option of spending seven days at the work farm. Later, Rogge was given a suspended sentence on payment of \$5 costs.
