

# DEVER TO BE ARRAIGNED ON AUTO OWNER'S CHARGE

Thomas Philip Dever was charged by Charles Jackson in municipal court yesterday with driving the latter's auto without his consent. Dever asked for an examination which Judge R. M. Funck set for this afternoon. Dever was released on \$500 bail.

Five were charged with speeding. Horace J. Olson pleaded guilty and was given a suspended sentence.
