

# THREE WITNESSES TESTIFY IN FAGEL LARCENY CASE

Three witnesses for the state testified yesterday in district court in the third criminal case on the September calendar, that of Abe Fagel, charged with second degree larceny. The witnesses who appeared before Judge W. L. Converse were Al Sedeen, Patrolman Eli Joseph LeBeau, and Lawrence Hoffman.

In the first criminal case begun Tuesday, the jury yesterday returned a verdict of guilty against William Lattin, charged with second degree forgery. In the second criminal case George Burrs, charged with first degree robbery, forfeited \$2,000 bail by not appearing and a bench warrant has been issued for his arrest. Spencer J. Searles, third assistant county attorney, is prosecuting for the state.
