

KOFERETH ISRAEL CONGREGATION TO BUILD SYNAGOGUE

Shaarai Tzedek Also Announces Tentative Plan for Erection of New Building.

The Kofereth Israel congregation has purchased lots 50 and 52, Third division, Duluth, the southeast corner lot on Fourth street and Third avenue East for the purpose of building a synagogue. The lot is 100 by 140 feet. Work will be started within a short time.

The present synagogue, a frame building, is at 323 East Fifth street, and has been in use 20 years.

Officers for the ensuing year are: M. Mattenson, president; K. Levine, vice president; A. Horwitz, treasurer; Maurice Cohen, secretary. Sol Kernes, Sam Stein, J. Averbook, Z. Kiel and Joseph Shelf are trustees.

The Shaarai Tzedek congregation, also is planning on building a new synagogue. The present building is located at Fourth avenue East and Ninth street. A bazaar will be held Sunday afternoon in Coffin's hall to help raise funds for the new building.
