

## CITY WINS IN DAMAGE SUIT OVER FLOODED STORM SEWER

The city of Duluth was given the verdict by a district court jury in the combined damage suits of \$1,500 each in which Horace C. Ross and Thomas C. Wilmot were the plaintiffs. The plaintiffs alleged their residences in West Duluth were damaged last June when a storm sewer flooded during a heavy rainfall.

C. L. Maas, suing Samuel I. Levin, doing business as the Holland Hotel company, was given a judgment of \$121.05 by a jury in Judge Hughes' court. Maas brought suit over a travelling bag and its contents he alleged he left at the hotel. Judge Hughes tried the case in Judge Ensign's courtroom.
