

DULUTH'S QUOTA IN WEEK'S DRIVE WILL BE \$20,000

Campaign for Funds for Palestine Restoration Work to Open June 21, Announcement.

A campaign to raise Duluth's quota \$20,000, of the \$10,000,000 to be raised in the United States for the Palestine Restoration fund will be launched Monday, June 21, according to the announcement of the committees which have been working on the plans. A banquet will be held on the opening day as a "starter."

An appeal will be made for the support of every Duluthian during the campaign at a mass meeting at the Shrine auditorium June 23. C. S. Cowen of New York and Dr. Peter Marcus of Minneapolis will be the principal speakers at the gathering.

For Palestine Restoration.

According to D. W. Loewus, captain of the teams which will canvass the city during the drive, the funds will be appropriated for the purchase of land in Palestine, the preparation of Palestine for settlement by the Jews and the maintenance and development of work already in progress in Palestine.

Of the \$205,000 to be raised in Minnesota, all but the amount assigned to Duluth has been turned over to the national committee. Seventy-five thousands dollars were contributed by Minneapolis, \$50,000 by St. Paul and \$60,000 by the other districts of the state.
