

WOMAN, INJURED BY AUTO, SUES DRIVER FOR \$5,000

Trial of the suit of Mrs. Eleanor Ericson, 2955 Devonshire street, against Harry Schapery, secretary of the Western Development company, living at 212 Third avenue East, for \$5,000 damages as the result of an automobile accident, started yesterday in district court. Mrs. Erickson alleges she suffered from shock two months after the accident July 26, 1920. The car driven by Schapery is curb after crashing into a smaller car, striking Mrs. Erickson who was pushing a baby carriage along the sidewalk. Judge Magney is presiding at the trial.
