

Alaska Survivor Former Duluthian

Lew White of Duluth, who was one of the survivors of the Alaska disaster, is the son of Mr and Mrs. H. Goldfarb, 817 Fourth avenue East. White is a professional comedian, his parents said last night. His name off stage is Lew Goldfarb.

White is 27 years old and a widower. He was born in Duluth, attended the public schools, and later was a newsboy. When about 20 years old, he took to the stage, and since has toured the United States in that profession. Five years ago he appeared at the Lyceum theater during a short engagement.

Recently Mr. and Mrs. Goldfarb had a letter from their son, in which he announced he was leaving the Pacific coast to begin an engagement at Chicago. His parents believe he was aboard the Alaska, en route to San Francisco, thence to Chicago; when his rescue from the Alaska followed the sinking of that vessel.

Besides his parents, Goldfarb has a sister in Duluth, Mrs. B. O. London, 913 East Fifth street.
