It had been hoped that Sokolow could be here for several days beginning Friday, but his health forbids a too strenuous program. When it is remembered that delegates are coming from distant cities for the privilege of seeing and hearing this leading Zionist, there is no doubt that Twin City Jews will be on hand to show their admiration of Sokolow. There will be no solicitation for funds. Instead the committees are bending every effort to have those who pledged in the recent drive cash in on their pledges at least in part, so that a substantial sum can be turned over to Mr. Sokolow, as a testimonial.

A. A. Cohn, Chas. L. Sipkins, to Attend

On Sunday, April 9th, there will be a nationwide conference at Detroit, Mich., of those who were active in the \$14,000,000 War Relief Drive. That city was selected because it is the home of David A. Brown, who headed the National Drive, devoting about six months exclusively to the planning and conducting of this stupendous relief undertaking. The conference will be in the nature of a testimonial to Mr. Brown. Reports of the campaign will be given in detail, and officers of the Joint Distribution Committee will give their report of projected constructive work in the War Regions, and the details of the proposed relief measures. There will also be addresses by men of national prominence including Rabbis Nathan Krass, Stephen Wise, Leon Harrison, Abba Hillel Silver, Emil G. Hirsch, Horace Wolf, and Messrs. Julius Rosenwald, Jacob Bilikopff, Judge Harry Fisher, James H. Becker, Miss Erma May and Dr. Cyrus Adler and Mr. Louis Marshall.


