

BUILDING PERMITS SOAR TO NEW HIGH TOTAL MARK

Building permits issued by the city building inspector for the week closed yesterday, exceeded all previous records for any seven-day period this year. The estimated value of permits soared to \$610,850 or \$210,000 higher than its previous record.

Apartment buildings were the determining factor in this exceptional total. Permits were granted for two apartment buildings Friday with an aggregate total expenditure planned of \$400,000.

Business recorded by the Duluth Builders exchange failed to reach its high figures of the previous week. The total contracts awarded during

the week was placed at \$253,559, while prospective plans still to be filed are estimated to carry buildings valued at \$330,000.
