Mrs. Mathilda Metzger Zien, age 53, former Duluth resident, died in Milwaukee yesterday according to information received here. She was a widow of Jacob D. Zien, Duluth merchant, who died in 1908. The body will arrive in Duluth tomorrow and will be taken to Temple Emanuel cemetery, Woodland, where funeral services and burial will be conducted.
