

Social Center Club Planned by Duluth Jews

A special committee consisting of J. Averbook, J. Abram and Abe Oreck, was appointed to ascertain available centrally located sites for a large Jewish social center to be built at an estimated cost of \$50,000 at a meeting of a committee of representatives of Duluth Jews at the Chamber of Commerce last night.

The building, according to Charles D. Oreckovsky, temporary secretary of the committee, will be the center of the Jewish social life of the city. It will be at least three stories in height and will consist of a complete set of clubrooms, meeting halls, reading and study rooms, swimming pool. The committee will report back to the general committee at its next meeting to be designated by Joseph Oreckovsky, temporary chairman.
