

Building Boom Reflected in Day's Permit Volume

Duluth's building boom continues according to records in the office of the city building inspector. Yesterday 15 permits were issued for new work to be done for an aggregate value of \$23,190. Of that sum seven permits were for new homes valued at a total of \$20,000 and \$3,190 in permits for new foundations, garages and other repair work.

Permits for new homes were issued to Levine Brothers, 821 Fourth avenue East, \$2,500; J. H. Miller, 1128 Fifty-fifth avenue West, \$1,000; Sam Passon, 432 East Eighth street, \$2,000; Joseph L. Klenow, 2238 West Twelfth street, \$4,500; Fred A. Berg, 127 East Eighth street, \$2,500; and Paul Paulson, 1910-12 East Eighth street, \$4,000.
