Forecast

IT IS HARDLY necessary to point out that conclusions are not better than the premises upon which they rest. If Russian policy becomes less negative and moves decisively in the direction of either more war or more peace, an immediate reappraisal of the whole domestic picture will be essential. As 1952 ends, business activity in the United States is higher than it ever has been before except during the boom period of the World War II. The stock market is at the highest level in 22 years.

Stock Study

Gleaner Harvester Corp. makes the "Gleaner-Baldwin Combine," which cuts and threshes grain in one operation. The company recently introduced a new wheel type combine for rice and is developing a new eight foot, self propelled machine, adaptable to the smaller acreage farmer, especially for areas where soybeans are grown. Capitalization consists entirely of common stock, with 400,000 shares outstanding. On a per share basis, net was \$2.81 in fiscal year to Sept. 30, 1952; \$2.27 in 1951; \$1.95 in 1950, \$1.96 in 1949 and \$6.32 (on the present number of shares) in 1948. On Sept. 30 current assets paid \$3,319,491 against current liabilities of \$1,661,581, leaving net working capital of \$5,717,910. Net tangible assets were equal to \$18.12 a share. Net working capital equaled \$14.29 a share. Common dividends have been paid in each year since 1936. The current \$2 annual rate has been in effect since 1950. In 1949, \$3.25 was paid, in 1948, \$4.20 plus 33 1/3 per cent. in stock, and in 1947, \$2.40.
